FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

Last Sunday certainly was not our finest hour as a parish or as an Italian community and the media, especially the Worcester Telegram, helped to remind us of it with their front page coverage. As I stood there with people throwing money in front of me, my thoughts were of the Jewish high priests throwing 30 pieces of silver at Judas for betraying Jesus. I have to admit that I was humiliated while some of you applauded. I am reminded of Jesus' words that "no prophet is without honor except in his native place."

A reporter from *Worcester Magazine* told me he didn't know if he was attending a meeting of church members or union members shouting out, demanding greater benefits. What an indictment of us! Are we a community of believers who treat each other as Christ would want us to or an angry crowd determined to get what we demand but wanting someone else to provide it and pay for it? Isn't that part of the socialist agenda?

We will put a temporary hold on the planned time frame, but we will still go forward in our effort to build a strong Italian Catholic community between both Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Our Lady of Loreto parishes. We will hold another meeting of both parishes on Sunday, March 20th at 1:00 pm in Mount Carmel center to continue our discussions about the future of our parishes and Mount Carmel church.

We have to face the truth and the issues at hand, however painful. Do we want to plan for future generations or do we want to let things at Mount Carmel simply die? Last Sunday showed me we have a lot of people who pay lip service and are present for dramatic and phony displays, but they are merely "empty gongs and clanging symbols," to borrow St. Paul's words. We need people who are going "to step up to the plate" and commit themselves to Mount Carmel and Loreto with more than meaningless and empty words. I believe God is with us, but we have to do our part with faith in God's goodness and guidance.
