

VISITATION HOUSE BABY BOTTLE DRIVE

Between Mother's Day and Father's Day, Our Lady of Loreto Parish will be participating in a Baby Bottle Fundraiser to benefit Visitation House, a Catholic home for homeless women facing crisis pregnancies. Since opening 11 years ago, on the Feast of the Visitation, Visitation House has cared for over 225 mothers and their babies. While women await the birth of their babies at the home on Vernon Hill in Worcester, MA, Visitation House feeds, clothes, educates, and nurtures them. After the birth of their baby, mothers can stay up to six months, during which time the staff at Visitation House assists them with housing, higher education, and job opportunities, and furnishes them with the basic necessities to start their new lives. Please support Visitation House by taking a baby bottle and filling it with your spare money. We will distribute them on May 7-8 and collect them on June 18-19.
