**Change in Bulletin Format**

Effective immediately, Mass Intentions for both Our Lady of Loreto and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel will be combined in the bulletin. Likewise, Sanctuary Lamp remembrances will also be combined. **Sanctuary Candles**

Notice that the two candles hanging above our tabernacle have been converted into sanctuary candles by changing the globes to red and using a special beeswax candle. They will remain perpetually lit along with the candle on the wall beside the tabernacle to indicate the presence of Jesus in the tabernacle. We have done this so that up to three candle remembrances can be made each week and to accommodate a long-standing practice at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish. Remembrances can be scheduled by calling the office.
