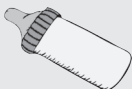

YEAR OF MERCY

During his October 2015 visit to America, Pope Francis visited Curran-Fromhold Correctional Facility in Philadelphia. As the white-robed pontiff moved among the inmates clad in their institutional blue-grey, some rose for a blessing, others clutched the papal rosaries they had received. All looked with a gaze of wonder. Were not these men and women hardened criminals? What could be the source of their joy? “I am here as a pastor, but above all as a brother,” Francis told them, “to share your situation and to make it my own...All of us need to be cleansed, to be washed. All of us. Myself, first and foremost...The Lord goes in search of us; to all of us he stretches out a helping hand.” Francis, the man in white, a rock star among world leaders, came to share his own deep need for mercy. One can imagine that, given the chance, he too might have donned a smock of grey.

**MOUNT CARMEL CHURCH BUILDING
RELIEF MOULDING AND CROSS**

The pictorial molding and cross which were atop the façade of the church have been placed in safe storage, thanks to Ed Amorello and his construction crew. Those items were removed by crane from the top of the building, and because of their weight, had to be moved using heavy machinery. The question was where to store them because of their size and weight. We were able to arrange a secure place for them.

MOUNT CARMEL CHURCH BUILDING

We discovered this week that one of the rosettes in the ceiling of the church had broken in half and shattered on the floor of the church. If anyone had been standing where it fell, he or she could have been severely injured or killed. This incident has been reported to the city’s Department of Inspectional Services and to our insurance carrier. The constant vibration emanating from the heavy and constant traffic on Rt. 290 continues to wreak havoc with the church building.
