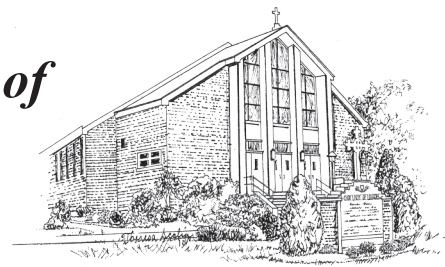

**YEAR OF MERCY**

“‘I was ill and you cared for me’ (Mt 25:36). Occasions for visiting the sick can be endless inasmuch as illness displays so many variations. The debilities of old age, the sorrows of cancer and disease, of mental and emotional trials—the occasions are plentiful if only we have the heart for great love. And who has not an opportunity often in a friend or family member? Yet the personal challenge in this corporal work of mercy requires a concentrated spiritual effort. St. Augustine described it this way. One must become as if sick oneself in drawing close to the sick, not as though having the same affliction, but by considering with sympathy how one would desire to be treated if sick oneself. The very sick person often suffers the depressing worry of being a burden to others. To encourage them, to shine hope on a possible recovery, to show our enjoyment of being in their company—these are true acts of mercy. The sick need to know from our own love for them that they have lost nothing of their essential attractiveness. ‘When you attend to the wounds and bruises of the poor, never forget they are Christ’s wounds’ (Mother Teresa). Jesus has chosen to unite himself with the person in his illness, just as he unites himself to all the sufferings and distress of the poor. And every gravely ill person, even someone we have known for long years, is always now a poor person. Our reverence for that same person, encountered in a different manner, must acknowledge this hidden presence of the Lord.”

**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION**

**All CCD classes for both Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Our Lady of Loreto will be held at Our Lady of Loreto parish center, directly behind the church.**

Children in public schools or non-Catholic private schools and academics should be attending religious education classes on a yearly basis. Children planning on receiving the Sacrament of First Holy Communion **must** attend classes for two years (Grade 1 and Grade 2.) Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation **must** attend classes for two years (Grade 9 and Grade 10.)

Children in parochial schools and private Catholic schools are required to attend classes only for one year (the year of preparation.) First Holy Communion is usually received in Grade 2 and Confirmation in Grades 9 or above. Registration forms are available in the office at the Mount Carmel Parish Center, Monday –Thursday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and in the front of the church at Our Lady of Loreto. There is a fee of \$25.00 per child or \$40.00 per family.
