

YEAR OF MERCY

"The work of mercy requires awareness of the quiet despair afflicting homeless people. It cannot stop at pity, which is so often detached from real compassion. We must allow ourselves to be moved by the plight of another and bend down in heart to the other. Availability, discrete sympathy, openness to conversation these are the true measure of charity in sheltering the homeless. If ever we befriend a homeless person, even more if we share our faith in the act, we may contribute to a soul's salvation. Touching the soul of another is the ultimate fruitfulness of this work...Yet we are not always the one who gives the gift in these settings. I will never forget one man who stayed for two weeks in the Missionaries of Charity shelter in the Bronx. Most of the nights he slept on the floor outside the locked chapel. He was quite sane and extremely well read, a scientist from Texas who had worked for the US military in the production of nuclear weapons. His stay in New York was only to await a friend's assistance before a trip to France and entry into a Trappist monastery. It was a deep lesson for me how much may be hidden underneath a threadbare appearance."

DISMAS HOUSE MINISTRY

Our Ministry to Dismas house was started at Our Lady of Mount Carmel—St. Ann and continues here at Our Lady of Loreto throughout the year even during the summer months. We visit Dismas House on the first Wednesday of each month starting around 5:00 p.m. and usually finish by 7:00 p.m.

For those who are not familiar with this parish ministry, Dismas House is a residence for former prison inmates who are trying to get their lives together—to reconcile with their families, friends and the community, to join 12-step programs and stay with them, and to be trained for productive jobs. We join many other spiritual communities who participate in feeding the residents of Dismas House—Catholic, Orthodox, Jewish and Protestant.

Once a month since November 2008, we have been serving a meal at Dismas House. The meal is prepared by our volunteers delivered and shared with the residents while sharing social time and conversation. Our deepest gratitude goes to the Dismas House "team" who have been so faithful to this ministry for the past eight years. God bless all of you!

REPAIRS TO THE FAÇADE OF MOUNT CARMEL CHURCH

As you know, we have been ordered by the city's Historical Commission to make the façade of the church safe.

Work will begin on this project immediately after the parish's Italian Festival. This project has three facets the banding of the steeple, the capping of the façade and a "tie back" system to secure the inner wall, which is leaning dangerously toward Mulberry Street. The project will hopefully be completed in a month. We are hoping there is no further hidden damage that could be uncovered once the side walls are opened to install the steel required for the "tie back." The estimated cost of this work is approximately \$200,000. Since the parish does not have this money, we have to borrow it from the Diocese. The Mount Carmel Preservation Society has promised me that they can raise this money by June 2017, and it will go directly to the Diocese to repay this loan. However, the inside of the church building is unsafe. The work on the facade does not make the building safe. A third rosette has now fallen, and plaster and sheets of paint continue to fall, as well. I reported this to the Inspectional Services of the City. Consequently, the church must be inspected by qualified structural engineers and meet city requirements before the public can be allowed back into the church. The cost involved in hiring a qualified structural engineer and any repairs required to do whatever interior work is necessary to obtain the permit of occupancy from the city must be borne entirely by the Mount Carmel Preservation Society. I refuse to place the burden of another capital campaign in any way, shape or form on the backs of the parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish. The first campaign to raise the money needed to fix the church failed miserably and it would be foolish to try again. And remember, this does not even touch the repairs needed for Mount Carmel Parish Center now estimated in the millions.


HARMONICA LESSONS

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

All CCD classes for both Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Our Lady of Loreto will be held at Our Lady of Loreto parish center, directly behind the church.

Children in public schools or non-Catholic private schools and academics should be attending religious education classes on a yearly basis. Children planning on receiving the Sacrament of First Holy Communion must attend classes for two years (Grade 1 and Grade 2.) Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation must attend classes for two years (Grade 9 and Grade 10.)

Children in parochial schools and private Catholic schools are required to attend classes only for one year (the year of preparation.) First Holy Communion is usually received in Grade 2 and Confirmation in Grades 9 or above. Registration forms are available in the office at the Mount Carmel Parish Center, Monday - Thursday from 8:00 a.m. -4:00 p.m. and in the front of the church at Our Lady of Loreto. There is a fee of \$25.00 per child or \$40.00 per family.

Classes will begin on Sunday, September 25. Grades Pre-K through Grade 4 will meet on Sunday mornings from 8:30 - 11:00 a.m. and includes attendance at the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Parents are asked to attend Mass with their children. Attendance in the pre-K and Kindergarten are not mandatory. Grades 5 - 10 will meet on Sunday mornings from 11:00 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. Students are required to attend Mass, it is suggested that they attend the 10:00 a.m. Mass.
