

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

Today is Father's Day, a time to remember, pray for, and honor our fathers. There is a story told by a man of watching his father pray at night. This man, as a young boy, would wake up occasionally to see the devotion of his father to prayer. Such witness made a deep impression on the young son. Who were this father and son? A young Karol Wojtyla – the future Pope Saint John Paul II – and his father.

Karol Wojtyla, Sr. recognized that a father's primary duty is to get himself and his family – wife and children – to heaven.

I remember as a child my father kneeling with me and my brother and sister at our beds and praying. He took us to Mass every Sunday at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church and I cannot honestly say we were the best behaved children. I'm sure we sometimes entertained (if not bothered) the people around us. But those memories of being with my father are still so vivid in my mind and will be forever.

It is essential for fathers to take the lead with their children. There was a study done by the Swiss government in 1994 and published in 2000, which revealed that the religious practice of the father of the family "determines the future attendance at or absence from church of the children. "The study found if a father doesn't attend church, "no matter how faithful his wife's devotions – only one child in fifty will become a regular worshipper. If a father does go regularly, 75% of the children will continue as churchgoers." This confirms the essential role of the father as spiritual leader, which I would believe is true fatherhood. A Catholic man's greatest duty is to lead his spouse and children to meet Christ in the Mass on Sunday and holydays of obligation as the Church teaches. Men leading their families to Mass will have a lasting impact.

So, on this Father's Day and everyday let us pray for our fathers and the indispensable and irreplaceable role they have in the lives of their children. And for those of us whose fathers have gone to the Lord, we say "thank you, Dad," and we still love you very much!

PASTORAL COUNCIL



My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On the weekend of **June 24**, our diocese will take up the Peter’s Pence Collection. Our participation supports the charitable work of Pope Francis as he reaches out to those who are marginalized and suffering around the globe. By supporting this collection, you join the Holy Father in bringing a little more mercy into the world.

Pope Francis challenges us to look at those around us with the eyes of mercy. At a Papal Audience he said, “We encounter so many weary and oppressed people today . . . And how is our heart? Is it merciful? And our way of thinking and acting, is it inclusive?” (Jubilee Audience, Nov. 12, 2016). I invite you to reflect on how you feel moved to answer the call to mercy.
